Parking Courtesy

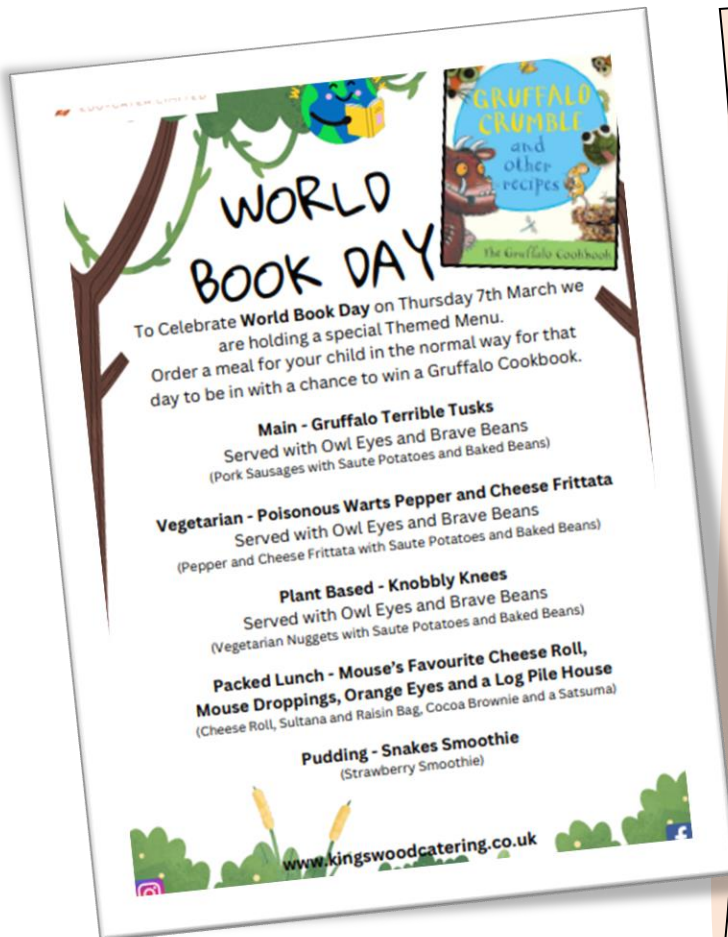
Please avoid driving along Scarborough Street in the morning rush hour and parking outside the school gates on double yellow lines on College Street.

Kingswood World Book Day special

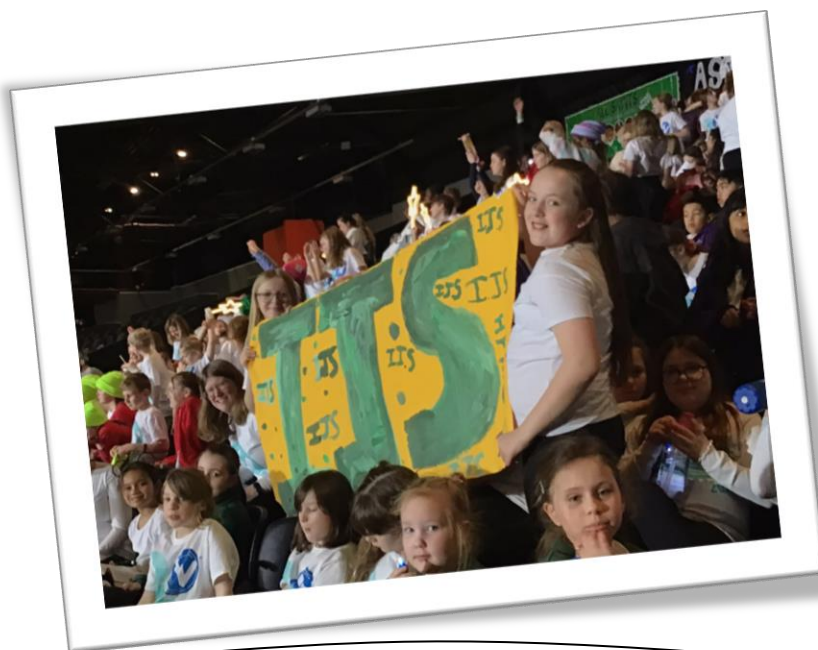
