The week before half term, our attendance was 94.61%. Overall this year, our attendance 95.6%. Our target attendance is 96%.

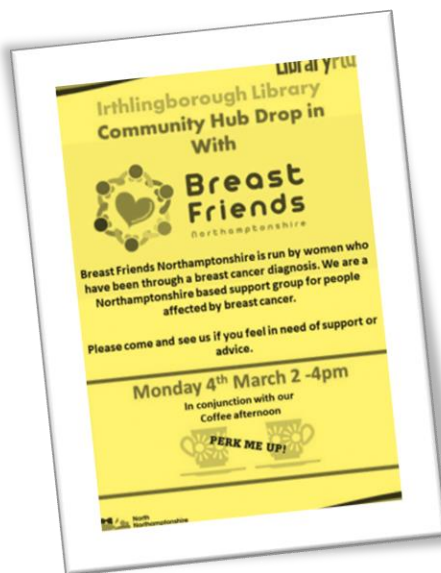
World Book Day!

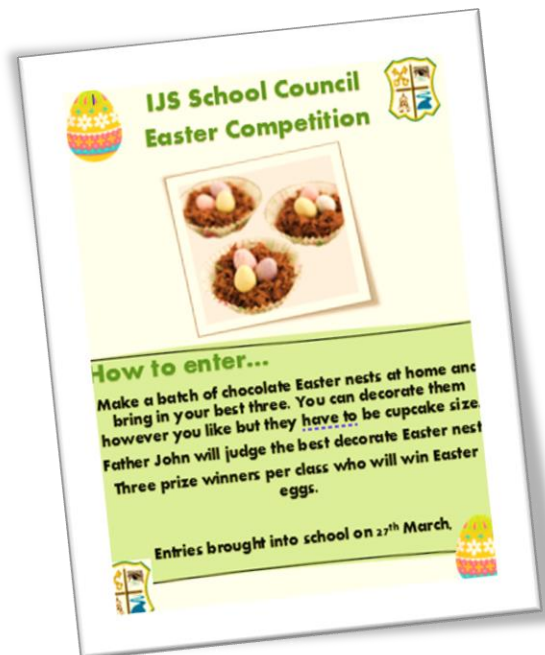


Community Hub Drop-in
